- Generate support for, and participation in, local anti-crime prevention efforts
- Strengthen neighborhood spirit and police/community partnerships
- Send a message to criminals that neighborhoods are organized and fighting back

Participating neighborhoods are asked to turn on outside lights, lock their doors, and spend the evening outside with neighbors, police, fire and other city officials. Neighborhoods will be hosting a variety of events ranging from small potlucks and BBQ's to large block parties.

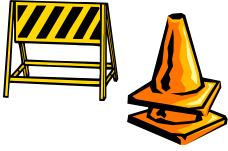
