

### PARKS, FIELDS, AND FACILITY INFORMATION PARK PERMITS

Parks shade structures are available for exclusive use. Reservations are available from 10 a.m. to dark on a first-come, first-served basis. Rental of the park is not required, however without a permit, the park area is open to the public. Park reservations are taken up to one year in advance. All park reservations must be made at the Parks & Recreation office. To find photos of specific parks please visit our website at cityofwoodland.org. No reservations Nov. 1 - Feb. 28.



Fees are listed for local non-profit and private group use.

No single site reservation at a park may be for groups larger than 50 people. Large groups may be required to provide additional equipment such as trash cans or portable restrooms. Additionally, large group reservations may need special approval from the Special Event Committee. The request for a permit of 50 or more must be submitted a minimum of 45 days prior to the event. Any event charging admission for commercial use requires permission through the Special Event Committee.

#### ATHLETIC FIELD RESERVATION PROCEDURES

All groups or teams who want to play league or tournament games on the fields, or any groups who want to use the athletic fields should proceed with the reservation process. All requests will be processed in order of receipt and must be made a minimum of seven days in advance. And no reservation request may be made more than twelve months in advance.




To apply for an athletic field, please adhere to the following procedures:

- 1. Complete and SIGN a Field Request Form. Do NOT include payment. Full payment is due upon approval and at the time the permit is issued (see number 3.)
- 2. Submit form to the Parks & Recreation office.

  The request will be evaluated for appropriateness and availability of facility.
- 3. If request if approved, reservation agreement will be completed and the applicant will be notified.


  Applicant will sign agreement form and submit payment in full, including required deposits and insurance.

Please note: Even with a permit, use may be cancelled if weather or field conditions are not suitable. League play without a permit is not allowed.
