Low and moderate income is defined as persons making 80% or less of the area median income in Woodland. As per HUD directives, priority is given to applicants providing services to Americans serving our Country and applicants who have demonstrated the ability to complete projects in a timely basis.

All interested parties are invited to attend an application workshop on **Friday, February 15, 2013 at 1:30 pm** in the City Council Chambers to discuss the 2013-2014 CDBG application and scoring criteria and to give citizen input on the 2013-2014 CDBG Program.
