Exploring Mare Island

Join a local guide to explore historic Mare Island and learn its importance in our country's defense. The tour includes the stately Colonial Mansions of Officers Row. The inside of the Admiral's Mansion welcomes the tour with its brass nautical lamps highlighting the graciousness of the interior of the beautifully restored period home. St. Peter's chapel was built in 1901 and is the oldest naval chapel in the United States. It contains one of the largest selections of Tiffany stained glass in the West. A special Naval memorabilia collection, dating back to the Civil War is on prominent display in the Chapel. And, of course, the Chapel showcases a pipe organ that is original to 1926.

Tour the artifacts Museum built in 1855 and be sure to see the 35 ft Patrol Boat with shark's teeth that stands guard a the entrance.

Visit the first dry dock built in 1870 on Mare Island. And the historical cemetery is the final resting place of the daughter of Francis Scott Key. Enjoy a delicious lunch in the Museum - Meatloaf, Mashed Potatoes & Gravy, Green Peas, Green Salad, Rolls and Butter and a Dessert.
