


## Water Conservation Data for June 2009





Cumulative Water Conservation Savings (Monthly savings through City rebates, leak repairs, and devices beginning April 2009) Cumulative Total Savings of 142,026 gallons/month



During June, the City of Woodland used 596,680,406 gallons of water, or 10,580 gallons per person. This amount was the lowest water use for the month of June in the last 4 years. The estimated monthly savings for June from city rebates and city leak repairs totaled 39,258 gallons. In addition, city staff responded to 9 water waste reports and distributed 26 various water conserving devices to Woodland residents.
