


Water Conservation Data for May 2009







During May 2009, the City of Woodland used 475,593,114 gallons of water, which is 8,433 gallons per person. 2009 is the lowest water use for the month of May in the last 5 years. The estimated new monthly savings for May from City rebates and City leak repairs totaled 24,684 gallons. Monthly savings attributable to rebates, repairs, and devices beginning in April 2009 totaled 102,768 gallons. In addition, City staff responded to 7 water waste calls and distributed 125 brochures on water conservation, 50 kids' activity items, and 50 Water-Wise in Woodland magnets in May.

Water conservation savings are based on averages from the *Handbook of Water Use and Conservation*, Amy Vickers.
