REALLOCATION OF POLICE DEPARTMENT SERVICES:

Mary Beth Wilson, Crime Analyst, presented a report on reallocation of Police Department services. The Department recommended prioritizing calls for response by a police officer. Minor calls for service would be handled by the dispatch operator. The reason for the recommendation is that the level of service is dependent on the availability of staff time. Due to the growth of the City and the inability of allocated staff in proportion to the growth in population, service levels need to be prioritized.

Lois Linford from the League of Women Voters of Woodland announced that Friday February 26, 1993 a hearing will be held on the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit from the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board to allow the Clearlake Oaks Water District to discharge their secondary treated effluent into Cache Creek via Sweet Hollow Creek.

Council Member concurred that Mayor Rominger should attend this meeting as the

representative of the City.

JOINT MEETING WITH WOODLAND ACCESS 43, A COMMUNITY CABLE ACCESS TELEVISION CHANNEL:

Members of the Woodland Access 43 Board presented an overview of the history and current status of the local access channel for Woodland. The benefits and potential use of the channel was presented. President Bonnie Freshwater made a funding proposal to the City Council.
