## REVIEW OF CITY INSURANCE POLICIES/CLAIMS PROCESS:

Pete Woodruff, Finance Director, and Jeff Davis, Yolo County Public Agency Risk Management Insurance Authority (YCPARMIA) Risk Manager, gave Council an overview of functions of the City's risk management program. The program is proactive by providing supervisor training and use of a risk loss officer in ensuring the work place is safe.

The Finance Director explained the City's insurance coverage for general and auto liability, workers' compensation, property and contractors equipment, fidelity and machinery. He also explained the formula for assessing the cost for coverage. Finally, a review of claim costs was conducted.

City Manager Kris Kristensen explained there are some limitations to what is covered through YCPARMIA. Earthquake, flood and intentional acts of officials are some of the significant items not covered through YCPARMIA.
