PUBLIC COMMENT:

No members of the audience requested to speak upon announcement of the public comment portion of the meeting by Mayor Pro Tem Timothy.

MORATORIUM ON BUILDING PERMIT ISSUANCE ALONG I-5 CORRIDOR:

Consideration of an interim emergency ordinance to impose a moratorium on building permit issuance along the I-5 corridor was continued from the April 16, 1991 Council meeting in order to have the required number of Council Members present to vote on the issue.

Ordinance No. 1185:

On motion of Mayor Holman, seconded by Council Member Flory and carried by unanimous vote of all Council Members present, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 1185, an interim emergency ordinance imposing a moratorium on the issuance of building permits for construction in specified areas adjacent to Interstate 5 to provide time for the Council to establish guidelines for site plan review.

REVIEW OF SPEED ZONE STUDY:

The Public Works Director made a presentation on the speed zone study. Members of the Traffic Safety Committee and staff of the Police and Public Works Departments also addressed the merits of the proposed speed zone changes. The

proposed speed zones will be presented as a regular item at the May 21, 1991 City Council meeting.

POLICE DEPARTMENT SPACE PROBLEMS:

Staff of the Police Department presented the current space problems of the Police Department and presented a staff analysis and recommendation of an interim solution to the problem until the new police facility is built. Council Members Crescione and Flory requested additional alternatives to be studied.

REVIEW OF ALARM ORDINANCE:

Police Lieutenant Del Hanson reviewed the proposed alarm ordinance. Implementation will require a part time Police Aide position which will be funded through alarm permit fees and fines.

ADJOURNMENT:

At 9:05 p.m. the meeting was adjourned to Monday, April 29, 1991, 6:30 p.m., Cafe California, Davis, California, for a joint meeting with the City Councils of Davis, Winters and West Sacramento.
