

# INTRODUCTION

The City of Woodland's Environmental Services Division oversees trash collection, recycling and other community environmental programs. Waste Management is Woodland's franchise waste hauler.

State law requires that we divert at least 50% of community solid waste from landfills through source reduction, recycling, and composting. In addition, in 2011, California set the ambitious goal of reaching a 75% diversion rate by 2020.

As of 2011, Woodland has reached a 62% diversion rate. We are working toward 75%.



This booklet is provided to help you understand how to do your part in helping Woodland meet its goal.

# WASTE MANAGEMENT SERVICES

## General Information

- Carts may not be serviced if they are overloaded, are not accessible, or include inappropriate materials.
- See *Holiday Service Delays* on the next page for exceptions to normal service.

## Residential Cart Services

- Place carts at the curb by 6:00 a.m. on service day and remove them within 24 hours.
- Place carts 3 feet apart and 3 feet from other objects.
- All carts are serviced weekly!

## Commercial Services

- Trash and recycling bins are available in several sizes.



Waste Management offers free assisted service to senior and disabled customers who are unable to roll their carts to the curb. To apply, call (530) 406-4332.

## Holiday Service Delays

There are no collection services on these holidays:

New Year's Day • 4th of July • Labor Day  
Thanksgiving • Christmas Day

If the holiday falls on a weekday, services will be delayed by one day the rest of that week. For example, if your normal service day is Thursday, during Thanksgiving week, your collection will be on Friday. Friday customers will be serviced on Saturday.

## Bulky Waste Event

Every year in April, Waste Management holds a Bulky Waste Drop-Off & Recycling Event for Woodland residents free of charge.

The following items are accepted for recycling or disposal:

- appliances
- clean wood
- rigid plastics
- flattened cardboard
- electronic waste
- furniture
- carpet
- other bulky waste

**No hazardous waste accepted!**

# TRASH

## Waste Services

All residential carts and commercial bins are serviced at least once per week. Businesses and apartments may request additional pickups. The items below are accepted in trash containers.

- Plastic bags / wrap
- Food waste
- Tissues / paper towels
- Foam containers
- Auto glass / safety glass
- Mirrors / windows
- Soil / dirt / sod
- Rocks / concrete
- Non-fluorescent light bulbs
- Pet waste
- Disposable diapers
- Juice / milk cartons

## It's Good For The Environment!

Reducing waste and recycling helps to conserve and protect our natural resources. It helps to preserve the environment, nature and wildlife for future generations.

## Residential Recycling

Curbside recycling is available to all residents in single family homes and is serviced weekly.

## Business & Apartment Recycling

State law and the municipal code require businesses that generate 4 cubic yards or more of waste per week and apartments with 5 or more units to have recycling programs.

All other businesses and apartments are also encouraged to recycle.

# HAZARDOUS WASTE

It's illegal to throw HHW in the trash!

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) is often toxic, corrosive or flammable and can pose a threat to human health and the environment if not disposed of properly.

- acids, poisons & solvents
- automotive products & fluids
- car & household batteries
- fire extinguishers
- fluorescent bulbs & tubes
- gasoline & flammables
- household cleaners
- paint (oil & latex)
- mercury thermometers & thermostats
- pesticides & herbicides
- pharmaceuticals (non-controlled)
- pool chemicals
- propane tanks
- syringes (containerized)
- used motor oil & filters
- ...and more!



# UNIVERSAL WASTE

Universal Waste is a more common type of hazardous waste that can still pose a threat to humans and the environment.

These items are accepted daily for free recycling at the Yolo County Landfill or at the following Woodland locations:



# USED OIL RECYCLING

## Curbside Collection

Recycle used motor oil and filters with residential curbside service. Here's how:

- Contact Waste Management of Woodland at (530) 662-8748 to get a free oil container and filter bag.
- Drain oil filter, then place empty filter into bag and seal tight. Drain used motor oil into container and secure cap.
- Place container and bagged filter at the curb on your normal cart service day.
  - A new filter bag will be left with your empty oil container.
  - Never mix used oil with other fluids or substances. It is illegal to pour oil down a storm drain or sewer.



Oil doesn't wear out, it just gets dirty!  
It can be re-refined into new oil that is just as good as virgin oil.

Used oil can be recycled for free at the following locations:

The best way to cut down on your waste is to reduce the amount of stuff you buy. The second best thing is to reuse it!

Here are some tips on reducing your waste:

Buy what you need and use what you buy

Close the loop--buy products made from recycled materials

Rent, lend or borrow instead of buying new items

Buy used items when possible

Donate used items to thrift stores or charities, or offer them, through consignment stores to others

Buy durable items that will last longer

Consider repairing items instead of buying new ones
