Members of the City Council have expressed a desire to support the location of Clark Pacific facilities at the Speckles site in Yolo County just north of Woodland. A RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR THE LOCATION OF CLARK PACIFIC FACILITIES IN
YOLO COUNTY

WHEREAS, Clark Pacific is recognized as an innovative leader within the Building and Construction Industry because of its commitment to high quality, pre-cast concrete; and

WHEREAS, Clark Pacific is interested in locating a manufacturing facility in Yolo County; and

WHEREAS, the City of Woodland and Yolo County mutually desire to work together to encourage economic development that benefits each agency; and

WHEREAS, a site is immediately needed by Clark Pacific for an outdoor fabrication plant by Spring 2008; and

WHEREAS, the Yolo County Board of Supervisors is encouraging some combination of industrial and agricultural industrial uses at the Spreckels site located just north of the Woodland City Limits; and

WHEREAS, the Spreckels site is previously disturbed, currently unused and the owners of the site have expressed the desire for this use; and

WHEREAS, Clark Pacific's location on the Spreckels site will generate up to 50 jobs and the potential for a future increased presence in the Yolo County area adjacent to Woodland, generating economic benefits to area residents and both local governments.

BE IT THEREFORE, RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Woodland, Yolo County, California that the Council hereby declares support for the location of Clark Pacific facilities in Yolo County.
