SUBJECT: Presentation on Smoke Free Multi-Unit Residences

**Report in Brief**

During the November 27 Council meeting, Council member Pimentel noted that the new multi-unit residence, Terracina at Spring Lake, is a smoke free apartment complex. The City Council expressed interest in learning more about smoke free multi-unit residences in order to explore the desirability of encouraging more such complexes in Woodland. Specifically, the Council expressed interest in mandating that any multi-unit residence that receives public housing funds be smoke free. While the Council expressed some interest in developing an ordinance that would facilitate this effort, it was also determined that a presentation on this issue would be more appropriate prior to providing staff with further direction. In response to the Council's comments, staff has scheduled a presentation on this issue from Steven Jensen, Tobacco Education Coordinator for the Yolo County Health Department. Mr. Jensen's presentation is scheduled for the March 18 Council meeting and is supported by the attached documents.

Staff recommends that the City Council receive the presentation on smoke free multi-unit residences and provide staff with additional direction.
