SUBJECT: 2008 Road Rehabilitation, Project No. 07-44;
Approve Plans and Specifications, and
Authorize Bid Advertisement

Report in Brief

The 2008 Road Rehabilitation (Lincoln Avenue) Project, No. 07-44, is the next major road repair project utilizing voter-approved Measure E funds. This project was approved in the December 4, 2007 Capital Budget submitted as part of the Mid Year Adjustments. The total project budget, including design and construction management costs is \$3,732,500. Plans and specifications for the project are complete and staff is prepared to release the documents for bidding upon Council authorization.

Staff recommends City Council approve the plans and specifications for the 2008 Road Rehabilitation, Project No. 07-44, and authorize bid advertisement.

Background

In 2006, voters approved the Measure E ½ cent sales tax along with advisory measures to ascertain voter preferences for use of those proceeds. Under the advisory measure, road maintenance received a very high voter response for securing 45% of Measure E tax proceeds to address city-wide road repair requirements. The rehabilitation of Lincoln Avenue from Sixth Street to County Road 98 was one of the major projects identified by the community, City Council and staff.

Discussion

This project rehabilitates Lincoln Avenue from Sixth Street to County Road 98, including side streets between Main Street and Lincoln Avenue from Sixth Street to West Street. In addition, and as necessary, sanitary sewer services (some of which are 100+ years old) will be renewed, water services will be renewed, behind-the-walk parallel water mains will be moved into the street, and water meters will be installed in preparation of the meter implementation program. The project

plans and specifications are available for review at the Public Works counter and explanations of project details, repair methods and treatment types are available from Public Works staff.

Upon Council authorization, bids will be solicited with a projected opening on or about May 22, 2008. If one or more bids are responsive and within the project budget, staff anticipates the bid award will be authorized on or about June 17, 2008 with construction beginning in July, 2008. Road segments and treatments are shown and summarized on the attached project map and street listings. This project will involve significant coordination with the public and especially the impacted residents and businesses through public notices, door hangers and neighborhood meetings prior to construction. Other than localized traffic will be detoured as necessary as work crews address the various utility repairs prior to pavement resurfacing. The primary types of pavement surface treatments include Fabric Cape Sealing and Micro Surfacing which are processes that require full road closures and parking restrictions during the work day application processes. These applications follow phased approaches which include reopening roads at the end of each work day.

Fiscal Impact

There is no impact to the General Fund. The total project budget is \$3,732,500; the engineer's estimate for the construction work is \$3,100,000. The project is entirely funded from Measure E, Water Enterprise, Sewer Enterprise, Road Development Funds, and the Proposition 1B Infrastructure Bond.




