

Traffic Safety Commission Regular Meeting Minutes of March 3, 2008

I. CALL TO ORDER

Meeting called to order at 6:32pm by Commissioner Mikalson

Commissioners Present: Mikalson, Jacks, Parker, Lemaire

II. MINUTES

Commissioner Parker moved to approve the minutes of the November 5th meeting. Commissioner Lemaire seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

III. PUBLIC COMMENT - None

IV. REGULAR AGENDA

A. I-5/SR 113 - Proposed conceptual detouring of traffic on to local streets for the construction of NB I-5/SB SR113 direct connector project. Mr. Robert Nguyen of Caltrans presented information regarding the project and the reasoning behind the request to detour traffic on to local streets.

Moved by: Commissioner Jacks to approve the detour concept as presented.
Seconded by: Commissioner Parker
Motion carried 4-0.

B. Gum Ave/Bourn Dr. Intersection Modification

Staff explained the reasoning behind the intersection modification to change the intersection back to a 4-way stop; the lack of funding and current level of service with the temporary roundabout. Staff wants to stress that this is a financial decision and not a policy decision regarding the use of roundabouts.

C. Speed Zone Survey Update

Staff presented the speed zone surveys and proposed changes to speed limit at following specific locations:

- a. East Street - The speed limit decreases from 45 mph to 40 mph from the south City limits to CR 24A and it decreases from 40 mph to 35 mph from just south of the signal at the mall entrance to Gum Ave.
- b. Ogden Street - No changes proposed
- c. CR 102 - The speed limit increases from 45 mph to 55 mph from the south City limits to the south edge of existing development
- d. Farmer's Central Road - No changes proposed
- e. Kentucky Ave - The speed limit increases from 45 mph to 50 mph from Pioneer Ave to the east City limits

Moved by: Commissioner Parker to approve the posting of speed limit changes as presented.

Seconded by: Commissioner Lemaire.

Motion carried 4-0.

D. 10 Year Capital Budget Draft Transportation Nominations

Staff presented and briefly explained the Transportation Capital Budget Nominations that have been submitted for the 10 Year Capital Budget.
