SUBJECT: 4th of July Celebration

Report in Brief

The Woodland Recreation Foundation voted on September 23, 2003 to be the primary organization sponsoring and organizing the Annual 4th of July celebration in Woodland. The Parks & Recreation Department also takes a lead role in assisting the Foundation with the organization and operation of the 4th of July Special Event.

Staff recommends that the City Council receive information on the 4th of July event.

Fiscal Impact

The City of Woodland provides \$5,000. The balance of the funding is provided by sponsors at \$3,000 each. Current Sponsors: Stantec, Ponticello, Nugget, Caliander Associates, Blackburn, and Woodland Healthcare Foundation. Bayside Church provides an in kind contribution by assisting with the provision of activities at the Bike Parade and Freeman Park activities.
