SUBJECT: Certificate of Appreciation for David M. Flory

### **Report in Brief**

David M. Flory has decided to direct his dedication to, caring for and expertise on the City of Woodland into other areas of service and did not run for a sixth consecutive term as a Member of the Woodland City Council. It is proper that this service be recognized accordingly.

Staff recommends that the City Council recognize David M. Flory with a Certificate of Appreciation for his twenty plus (20+) years of dedicated, devoted service to the City of Woodland and wish him well in his new endeavors. The Certificate will be officially presented to Dave at a gathering next week.

### **Background**

Dave began his formal service to the City of Woodland on April 19, 1988 after winning his first successful campaign for office. He listed himself as a Woodland Business Owner and Administrative Assistant in the California State Assembly. Some of things he cited as being goals for him while in office that were of concern were the "rapid growth, the deterioration of the downtown and the number of vacant buildings in our commercial areas". Dave was re-elected to his second term on April 21, 1992, third term on April 9, 1996 and on March 21, 2000 began his first term as Vice Mayor. From March 19, 2002 through March 16, 2004 he was Mayor and upon re-election to his fourth term on March 16<sup>th</sup>, became Vice Mayor for the second time. His last two years in office, that of March 2006 through July 1, 2008 he has served as Mayor for the second time. Dave's accomplishments are so numerous they could not be successfully listed in this Communication but have been identified as much as possible on the Certificate he will receive from Council and staff.

The City of Woodland, its' citizens, staff and visitors simply need to look around them and much of that which has progressed in this City over the last 20 years has Dave's fingerprints all over it.
