SUBJECT: 2010 ARRA Road Project, Project No. 09-28; Approve Plans and Specifications, and Authorize Bid Advertisement

Report in Brief

The 2010 Road Project utilizes remaining ARRA funds from the completed CR102 project to micro surface portions of Ashley Avenue, Cottonwood Street, Cross Street and Beamer Street. This project is included in the FY09/10 mid-year Capital Budget. The total available project funding is \$415,074. To ensure the project bids are not above the available funding, the project will be bid with additive alternates. Plans and specifications for the project are complete and ready for bidding upon Council authorization.

Staff recommends City Council approve the plans and specifications for the 2010 Road Project, Project No. 09-28, and authorize bid advertisement.

Background

The American Reinvestment and Recovery Act (ARRA) was signed by President Obama on February 17, 2009. The bill included approximately \$72 million in road funding for the Sacramento Area Council of Government (SACOG) area. The funding was distributed through pre-established mechanisms used to distribute annual funding. The City of Woodland's Tier 1 allocation used for County Road 102 was \$655,725. The City's Tier 2 allocation of \$327,863 is the funding source for this project.

Discussion

The project will perform preventive maintenance and rehabilitate the subject pavement by placing a micro surface treatment on the pavement. The roadways were selected based on their existing condition and their roadway classification.

The ARRA funding may only be used on arterial and collector streets and the micro surfacing treatment is only appropriate on pavements that are within specific deterioration limits. All of the listed streets meet these criteria.

The project plans and specifications are available for review at the CDD counter in the City Hall Annex. Explanations of project details, repair methods and treatment types are available from CDD Transportation staff at 661-5961.

Upon Council authorization, the bids will be solicited with a projected opening date of March 23, 2010. If one or more bids are responsive and within the project budget, staff anticipates the bid award will be scheduled for the April 20, 2010 Council meeting and construction could begin in early May.

Fiscal Impact

The project includes \$327,863 ARRA and \$87,211 Measure E funds as included in the FY09/10 mid-year Capital Budget. The total project budget is \$415,074. There is no impact to the General Fund.
