The Woodland City Council met in regular session at 7:00 p.m.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:

Mayor Rominger invited everyone present to join her in the pledge of allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Yolo County Board of Supervisors Lynnel Pollock and Tom Stallard presented a Resolution on behalf of the Board of Supervisors to Mayor Elaine Rominger for her commitment to serving the City of Woodland.

Rick Gonzales, Executive Director of the Mexican American Concilio, said the Concilio is looking forward to better times, and he expressed his support of incoming Mayor Melton Losoya.

Ann Marie Barros, representing a "growing population" of newcomers to Woodland, said she appreciated working with Mayor Elaine Rominger while she was on the Council. She said she appreciated her high integrity, her honesty, and her friendship.

REPORTS OF CITY MANAGER:

CONSENT CALENDAR:

On motion of Council Member Borchard, seconded by Council Member Flory and carried by unanimous vote, the City Council approved the following Consent Calendar items:

MINUTES:

The City Council approved the minutes of the regular Council meeting of April 21, 1998, as prepared.

RESOLUTION NO. 4068 - RESULTS OF JUNE 2, 1998 ELECTION:

The City Council adopted Resolution No. 4068 declaring the results of the General Municipal Election held in the City of Woodland on June 2, 1998. Steve E. Borchard and Neal M. Peart, having received the highest number of votes for two vacancies on the Council, were elected Council Members. Margaret Vicars was elected as City Treasurer, and Jean Winnop was reelected as City Clerk.

RESOLUTION NO. 4069 - APPRECIATION FOR MAYOR ROMINGER:

The City Council adopted Resolution No. 4069, a resolution of appreciation honoring retiring Mayor and Council Member Elaine Rominger (Mayor Rominger abstained from voting on this agenda item).

OATH OF OFFICE - CITY CLERK AND CITY TREASURER:

Mayor Rominger administered the oath of office to City Clerk elect Jean Winnop and City Treasurer elect Margaret Vicars.

PRESENTATIONS TO RETIRING MAYOR ROMINGER:

Vice Mayor Melton Losoya presented a plaque and a framed Resolution of Appreciation (Resolution No. 4069) to Mayor Elaine Rominger.

Mayor Rominger introduced members of her family and thanked citizens of Woodland for supporting her during her term of office and thanked members of City staff and other local agency representatives who worked with her.

OATH OF OFFICE - COUNCIL MEMBERS ELECT BORCHARD AND PEART:

The City Clerk administered the oath of office to new Council Members elect Steve Borchard and Neal Peart. (The new reorganized City Council now was comprised of Council Members Melton Losoya, Steve Borchard, David Flory, Daniel Ryhal and Neal Peart.)

ELECTION OF MAYOR:

The City Clerk conducted the election of the Mayor.

On motion of Council Member Borchard, seconded by Council Member Flory and carried by unanimous vote, the City Council appointed Melton Losoya as Mayor.

ELECTION OF VICE MAYOR:

Mayor Losoya conducted the election of the Vice-Mayor.

On motion of Council Member Ryhal, seconded by Council Member Flory and carried by unanimous vote, the City Council appointed Steve Borchard as Vice Mayor.

REMARKS FROM COUNCIL MEMBERS:

Newly sworn Council Members Steve Borchard and Neal Peart gave thanks to family and friends who helped with their respective campaigns and talked about their hopes for serving on the Council for the next four years. Council Member Flory, Council Member Ryhal and Mayor Losoya thanked former Mayor Rominger for her services on the City Council and also commented on their desires for their upcoming years on the Council.

At 7:45 p.m. there being no further business the meeting was adjourned to June 23, 1998, at 7:00 p.m. Mayor Losoya invited everyone present to have cake and punch which was to be served in the first floor lobby of City Hall.
