The Woodland City Council met in adjourned session at 7:00 p.m.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Public comment was requested. No comments were received.

INTERSTATE 5/STATE ROUTE 113 CONNECTION STUDY ALTERNATIVES:

Public Works Director Gary Wegener outlined the I-5/SR 113 freeway connection improvement study and introduced consultant Tim Fleming with the firm of Mark Thomas and Associates who have been retained by the City to conduct the study. Mr. Fleming reviewed work done on the project to date.

Mr. Fleming recommended the Council narrow the focus of further study to six options. This would include Options 1B, 1C, 1D, 1E, 2 Expressway, and 3.

Tom Lumbrazo suggested further analysis be done on possible State and Federal funding for the project. He suggested considering an arterial concept with Option 3 as well.

Charlotte Germeshausen lives on Deaner Avenue and expressed concerns that all alternatives in Option 1 would cause greater freeway noise problems than what exists today. She is opposed to those alternatives.

Jim Moir also expressed concerns on Option 1 and the impacts they represent to his family's business near East Main Street.

On motion of Council Member Ryhal, seconded by Council Member Flory and carried by unanimous vote, the City Council agreed to continue to study Options 1B, 1C, 1D, 1E and Option 3, including both an expressway and an arterial alternative, and Council included in the motion a request to evaluate further ways to minimize impacts of Option 1 alternatives on the Germeshausen property.
