YOLO COUNTY TRANSPORTATION TASK FORCE FINAL REPORT:

Terry Bassett (Yolo County Transit Authority Transit Director), representing the Yolo Transportation Task Force, presented the Task Force's final report to the Council. Discussion followed. Mayor Sandy, the City's representative to the Task Force, also provided his views of the report.

On motion of Council Member Flory, seconded by Mayor Sandy and carried by unanimous vote, the City Council unanimously voted to accept the report.

POLICE STATION SITE STUDY:

Police Chief Russ Smith introduced Peter Hourihan and Chris Kamages of Ekona Architecture and Planning of San Francisco who had earlier in the year been approved by the Council to analyze three possible sites for a new City police station. The representatives gave the Council a review of the draft materials which they have developed so far in their work. Discussion followed. Kip Engstrom spoke to the Council regarding the Woodland Shopping Center site. Comments were requested so that the final report can be completed within two weeks.

The Chief asked for questions on the Department's 1994 Annual Report. Discussion followed. Several Council Members complimented the Department on its accomplishments.
