The Woodland City Council met in adjourned session at 7:05 p.m. in the City Hall Council Chambers. Vice Mayor Rominger called the meeting to order.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

The City Manager reminded the Council about a seminar on March 9, 1995 in Sacramento discussing liability issues for elected council members and volunteer board and commission members which is being conducted by the City's contracted City Attorney firm of Kronick, Moskowitz, Tiedemann and Girard.

JOINT MEETING WITH PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION:

This was a joint meeting between the Council and its Parks and Recreation Commission.

Parks and Recreation Commissioner Marlin Davies outlined current and future needs for new parks and facilities. Also discussed was the need to work cooperatively with other agencies, such as schools, to maximize joint facility development opportunities as well as the need to distinguish park needs from ballfield needs.

Commissioner Stoffregen outlined concerns with the approach to preparing the Fiscal Year 1995-96 Department operations and maintenance budgets. Further cuts in the budget will be very difficult to accommodate said the Commission.

Commissioner Beard discussed maintenance agreements with volunteer groups. Specifically, the Woodland Adult Softball Association agreement for Dubach Park was reviewed. Conditions for maintenance of the proposed Storz pond soccer fields were also considered.

At 8:22 p.m. there was a break in the meeting.

JOINT MEETING WITH CHILD CARE COMMISSION:

The Council reconvened to a joint session with its Child Care Commission.

Parks, Recreation and Community Services Director Tim Barry reviewed a Yolo County Resource and Referral Consolidation Status Report (copy attached).

Child Care Commission Chair Tania Garcia outlined the Child Care Division's Evaluation Summary for Fiscal Year 1994-95 (copy attached). The Commission requested feedback from Council on the child care work program.

Commissioner Carol Souza-Cole presented a report on a possible City Child Care Ordinance (copy attached).
