The Woodland City Council convened a special session at 5:00 p.m. and immediately adjourned to closed session in the Second Floor Conference Room of City Hall for a conference with City Manager Kris Kristensen to discuss Labor Relations, Government Code Section 54957.6. Council Members present at the meeting were: Sandy, Borchard, Flory, Rominger, and Slaven; absent: none. No other staff members were present at the meeting.

Council adjourned the closed session and the special session at 7:00 p.m.

CITY MANAGER ANNOUNCEMENT:

City Manager Kris Kristensen announced that the Council met in closed session from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. to discuss Labor Relations regarding all City of Woodland bargaining units pursuant to State Government Code Section 54957.6. He said no Council action was taken at the meeting.

The Council convened the adjourned session at 7:08 p.m. in the City Hall Council Chambers.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

There were no comments from the public.

POLICE STATION SITE SELECTION PROCESS:

Police Chief Russ Smith reviewed the history of the need for an expanded police station facility. He outlined steps taken to date and options available to the City. He requested direction from Council.

Following discussion the Council indicated it would like additional study on the following sites:

1. Main Street between Fifth and Sixth Streets
2. Woodland Shopping Center
3. 509 Fifth Street (Woods property)
4. 435 Court Street (Gilmartin property)

Staff will return at a regular meeting with a proposal for further study on these sites.

STREET NAMING POLICY:

Fire Chief John Buchanan reviewed the City's street naming policy and a recent request by Robert Gillette.

On motion of Council Member Borchard, seconded by Council Member Slaven and carried by unanimous vote, the City Council agreed to bring the proposed change in the street name policy to a public hearing at the Council's September 6, 1994 regular meeting and to invite groups associated with the development of the street name policy to attend and participate in the hearing.

WASTEWATER INDUSTRIAL PRETREATMENT PROGRAM:

The City's consultant on the Wastewater Industrial Pretreatment Program, Larry Walker Associates, gave an update on the program. Options on possible fee schedules to support continued operation of the program were reviewed and discussed by Council.

WATER ISSUES:

Council agreed to hold a special session to discuss various water issues on Tuesday, September 13, 1994, at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers.

REDEVELOPMENT CITIZENS' ADVISORY COMMITTEE APPOINTMENT:

The Redevelopment Agency business regarding the appointment to the Redevelopment Citizens' Advisory Committee was not ready for action. As a result the scheduled Agency Board meeting was not held.

EVENTS TO HONOR WOODLAND BABE RUTH TEAMS:

Council was advised of City activities planned to honor Woodland Babe Ruth teams on Saturday, August 27, 1994. Council expressed a desire to meet prior to that date to approve a resolution honoring Woodland Babe Ruth teams. Council agreed to meet at noon, Friday, August 26, 1994, to do so.
