Council met in adjourned session at 7:34 p.m. in the City Hall Council Chambers with the Woodland Joint Unified School District Board of Trustees.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

After introductions were made members of the audience were invited to offer comments. There were no comments presented.

WOODLAND HIGH SCHOOL RESIDENTIAL PARKING PERMIT PROGRAM:

Karen Prado, resident near Woodland High School, explained that as a resident she appreciated the Residential Parking Permit program and thanked the School Board and the Council. She requested that the preferential parking program committee meet twice annually to discuss program problems and concerns.

"NIGHT HOOPS" PROGRAM:

Police Captain Russ Smith and Recreation Program Manager Dan Rice gave a report on the "Night Hoops" Program.

SCHOOL CROSSING GUARD PROGRAM:

Police Captain Russ Smith gave an overview of the proposed changes to the school crossing guard program. The proposal includes having crossing guards at Cross and Elm

Streets and on Matmor Road at Prairee School where warranted. Alternatives will be reviewed for the other sites with some recommended to be discontinued. The District will determine the priorities. Staff of the Police and Public Works Departments indicated they will be available to provide technical assistance to the District on the program.

WATER CONSERVATION EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS:

Harrison Phipps, the City's Water Conservation Coordinator, presented teacher survey results and then presented the proposed program for water conservation school programs.

DOUGLASS JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL STREET CROSSING:

Public Works Director Gary Wegener provided a report on Douglass Junior High School street crossing improvements. He explained the need to get an agreement with the District on the school site improvements required.
