PAVEMENT MANAGEMENT PROGRAM:

Engineering Technician Asa Utterback presented information on the City's pavement management program. He explained that the program provides a systematic method for evaluating pavement maintenance. Public Works Director Gary Wegener discussed the backlog of overlay projects with Council and the need to fund these projects.

WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT STAFFING AND CLASSIFICATION:

Senior Civil Engineer Mike Horgan provided Council with information on staffing needs which are a result of new Federal regulations on pretreatment standards.

PROCLAMATION - LAW DAY USA:

On motion of Mayor Rominger, seconded by Council Member Crescione and carried by unanimous vote, the City Council approved the proclamation of May 1st as "Law Day USA" in Woodland.

CITY GOALS:

Council reviewed the tentative City goal statements they established June 15,

1992. The City Manager said that he would finalize the goals and include objectives.
