ORDINANCE NO. 1209 - TRANSIENT OCCUPANCY TAX:

The City Council adopted and read by title only Ordinance No. 1209, "An Ordinance of the City of Woodland Amending Section 23.49 of Article III, Chapter 23 of the Code of the City of Woodland Concerning Transient Occupancy Tax."

ORDINANCE NO. 1210 - DOCUMENTARY TRANSFER TAX:

The City Council adopted and read by title only Ordinance No. 1210, "An Ordinance of the City of Woodland Amending Section 23.62 of Article IV, Chapter 23 of the Code of the City of Woodland Concerning Documentary Transfer Tax"

RESOLUTION NO. 3658 - RESULTS OF APRIL 14, 1992 ELECTION:

The City Council adopted Resolution No. 3658 declaring the results of the General Municipal Election held in the City of Woodland on April 14, 1992. Gary Sandy, David Flory and Jack Slaven, having received the highest number of votes for three vacancies on the Council, were elected Council Members.

RESOLUTION NO. 3659 - APPRECIATION FOR MAYOR HOLMAN:

The City Council adopted Resolution No. 3659, a resolution of appreciation honoring Mayor Dudley Holman.

PRESENTATIONS TO RETIRING MAYOR HOLMAN:

Retiring Mayor Dudley Holman gave his remarks about serving on the Council for the past twelve years. Vice-Mayor Rominger presented a plaque and a framed Resolution of Appreciation to Mayor Holman. She also presented a framed photograph signed by the other Council Members to Mayor Holman, and Council Member Crescione also made a presentation to him.

OATH OF OFFICE - COUNCIL MEMBERS ELECT SANDY, FLORY AND SLAVEN:

The City Clerk administered the oath of office to new Council Members elect Gary Sandy, David Flory and Jack Slaven. (The new reorganized City now was comprised of Council Members Elaine Rominger, Joe Crescione, David Flory, Gary Sandy and Jack Slaven.)

ELECTION OF MAYOR:

The City Clerk conducted the election of the Mayor.

On motion of Council Member Flory, seconded by Council Member Crescione and carried by unanimous vote, the City Council appointed Elaine Rominger as Mayor.

EXCHANGE OF GAVELS:

Former Mayor Holman presented newly appointed Mayor Rominger with his gavel. Mayor Rominger presented Mr. Holman with an engraved gavel.

ELECTION OF VICE MAYOR:

Mayor Rominger conducted the election of the Vice-Mayor.

On motion of Council Member Flory, seconded by Council Member Crescione and carried by unanimous vote, the City Council appointed Gary Sandy as Vice Mayor.

ADJOURNMENT:

At 8:35 p.m. there being no further business the meeting was adjourned to April 28, 1992, at 7:00 p.m. Mayor Rominger invited everyone present to have cake and punch which was to be served in the second floor lobby of City Hall.
