The Woodland City Council met in adjourned session at 7:00 p.m.

DROUGHT RESPONSE PLAN:

Ron Tribbett, Public Works Director, provided an overview of the proposed Drought Response Plan. The major provisions of the plan are to enact public awareness, education, and conservation measures in response to the severity of a drought situation. The City Council discussed the plan but delayed adopting the plan until the Public Works Director returns with a more detailed description of duties for a proposed staff addition.

URBAN WATER MANAGEMENT PLAN:

Mike Horgan, Utilities Engineer, presented a summary of the provisions of the Urban Water Management Plan. Upon recommendation of City Manager Kris Kristensen, Council directed that the staffing issue for the Plan be reviewed separately. Council discussed the fact that they had the ability to review and update the plan as needed.

On motion of Council Member Sandy, seconded by Council Member Flory and carried by unanimous vote, the City Council adopted the Urban Water Management Plan.

PARK DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS:

Parks and Recreation Commissioner Dr. Skip Davies with the assistance of Parks and Recreation Director John Suhr presented an overview of the park development projects of the City.

FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION HEARING:

Mayor Holman, Council Member Flory, Council Member Crescione, and the City Manager volunteered to attend the Federal Aviation Administration hearing to be held in West Sacramento on April 3, 1991.
