The Woodland City Council met in adjourned session at 7:00 p.m.

ROLL CALL:

RIBBONS ON MAIN STREET AND HERITAGE PLAZA:

Ute Turner, representing the Desert Storm Support Group in Woodland, discussed its request to have red, white and blue ribbons placed on the new street light poles in Heritage Plaza and along Main Street in Downtown. After some discussion the Council informally agreed to the request with the understanding that (1) City forces would install the ribbons; (2) that the ribbons would be replaced by the group in the event they become vandalized or deteriorated; and (3) that they would be removed after the 1991 Memorial Day weekend unless Council agrees that they remain for a longer period. The group would coordinate pole usage with the Downtowners organization.

DRUG AND ALCOHOL ABUSE FORUM:

Council also considered the March 7, 1991 forum on drug and alcohol abuse sponsored by Yolo County. Council informally indicated its endorsement of the forum.

CLOSURE OF MILITARY BASES IN SACRAMENTO AREA:

Council considered a discussion paper on the potential closure of military bases in the Sacramento area received from the County of Sacramento. After some discussion no action was taken.

FISCAL YEAR 1990-91 OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE BUDGET:

Finance Director Pete Woodruff presented information on the FY 1990-91 Operations and Maintenance Budget which the Council will be asked to take final approval action on at its March 5, 1991 regular meeting. Also Council considered the concept of

establishing a policy on budget reserves for unexpected emergencies.

QUARTERLY BUDGET REPORTS:

Council discussed the quarterly budget reports it has received recently. Council expressed general approval of the report and directed staff to continue their preparation.

FISCAL YEAR 1991-92 OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE BUDGET PROCESS:

Council considered and approved a preparation and review schedule for the Fiscal Year 1991-92 Operations and Maintenance Budget. Council indicated their desire to hold a budget information workshop for interested Council Members from 6:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. Monday morning, March 25, 1991.
