ACQUISITION OF YUBA COLLEGE BUILDING/LEASE OF HOLY ROSARY CHURCH  
GROUND:

Park and Recreation Commissioner Marlin "Skip" Davies, Park and Recreation Director John Suhr and the City Manager reviewed an opportunity to acquire the Yuba College building on California Street and a ground lease from the Holy Rosary Church to keep the building on its present site and use it for Park and Recreation Department Offices/adult program space.

During discussion Council Members expressed an interest in having the facility available for youth ball fields on a temporary basis. Staff expressed a similar interest but noted that the church was reluctant to agree to this possibility. Staff will continue to pursue this idea.

On the motion of Council Member Flory, seconded by Council Member Sandy, Council unanimously (4-0) authorized the City Manager to negotiate with Yuba College and Holy Rosary Church for the building acquisition and ground lease. Any results from these negotiations will require subsequent Council approval.
