# ~ 319 Oak Avenue ~



- *Constructed in 1892*
- *Italianate Victorian cottage design*
- *Entrance porch featuring turned posts, spindle work, balustrades, and decorative eave brackets*
- *Original redwood exterior*
- *Recognized by the Daily Democrat for its demonstrated pride of ownership shown by extensive renovation and repairs*

# ~ 152 First Street ~

---



- *Constructed in 1910*
- *Craftsman Home*
- *Hipped roof with an off set front gabled porch*
- *Geometric patterns on glazed windows*
- *Extended elaborated rafter ends*
- *Victorian style brackets and paired Tuscan columns on the front porch*

# ~ 555 College Street ~




- *Constructed in 1912*
- *Modernist design*
- *Light colored stucco and flat roof*
- *Sturdy pergola with colonnade*
- *Use of palm trees*

## *~ 241 Cross Street ~*

---



- *Constructed in 1918*
- *Unique Craftsman “Modest Bungalow”*
- *Unique rafter tails*
- *Unique dormer with 9 horizontal window lites*



# ~ 33 Third Street ~

---



- *Construction in 1879*
- *Italianate Victorian design*
- *Showpiece of early Woodland architecture*

## ~ 945 North Street ~



- *Constructed between 1912 and 1926*
- *Shallow classical ornamentation typical of the Beaux Arts style*
- *Subtle variegation and specific shaping of the concrete blocks leads to a look of true stone*
- *Decorative casts around the recessed windows*
