- *Georgian Revival style*
- *Constructed in 1927*
- *Motroni designed home*
- *Crafted from brick with symmetrical shuttered windows, small porch and doorway with glass side panels.*
- *Columns supporting a pediment.*

- *Victorian Cottage style (Folk Victorian)*
- *Constructed in 1886*
- *Features Victorian-era elements such as horizontal wood siding, tall double-hung windows and a wide sitting porch*




# *~ 804 College Street ~*
