- *Owned by David & Kathy Henderson & Family*
- *Constructed in 1924*
- *Designed by Paul & Aileen Leake*
- *California Bungalow Style*
- *Prairie Style influences with the low pitch roof and brick accents.*



901 First Street



- *Owned by Mary Lacky*
- *Constructed in 1924*
- *Tudor Revival home style*
- *Has a simplified Old World feel in the multi-gabled rooflines with the flattened ends or “jerkinheads” and tight eaves.*



~ 211 Pendegast Street ~



- Owned by Tami & Bonnie Cuccia
- Constructed in 1879
- Originally owned by Drewry Robert Clanton, a cousin to Ike and Billy Clanton of the "Gunfight at the OK Corral."
- Nearby Clanton Avenue and Clanton Way likely named after the brothers.

- *Owned by Lakeview Properties*
- *Constructed in 1869*
- *Contributor to the Downtown Woodland Historic District and listed on the National Register of Historic Places. The Hotel operated through the 1920s with variety of commercial enterprises on the first floor.*
