**Q2. What is the scope and estimate of the construction project?**

A2. The scope is detailed in the two grant applications (see links above) and consists of streetscape improvements. The grant includes a new signal on Main Street at Fifth Street which will not be part of this project; however modifications to the signal on Main Street at Third Street will remain in the project. The construction estimate is \$800,000.

**Q3. Are there any DBE requirements?**

A3. No. Not for the design contract.
