Residential Rebate Program Policy High Efficiency Clothes Washer

The City of Woodland is offering a **\$100 rebate** during the 2008/2009 fiscal year to residents who replace their existing standard-efficiency clothes washer with a High Efficiency Clothes Washer (HECW). Washing machines must be purchased between January 1, 2008 and June 30, 2009, to be eligible. **Newly purchased HECWs must be a tier 2, 3 product on the Consortium for Energy Efficiency's (CEE) Qualifying Product List.** For a list of qualifying washers, please visit the Consortium for Energy Efficiency (CEE) website at www.cee1.org, the city's website at www.cityofwoodland.org or call the city at 406-5100. Funding for the program is limited, so receipt of a rebate will depend on the availability of funds when your application is received. Applications will be processed in the order that they are received, on a first-come, first-served basis. You may wish to contact the City prior to purchasing your HECW to confirm the availability of rebates.

High Efficiency Clothes Washers use up to 72 percent less energy and up to 57 percent less water compared to standard-efficiency washers. They are projected to save as much as 475 kWh per year when used with an electric water heater and electric dryer. Savings are projected to be up to 13 therms of gas per year when used with a gas water heater and gas dryer. Potential water savings are estimated at up to 8,000 gallons annually.

*HECW rebates are only available for Woodland residents within the City limits. Please submit a copy of the sales receipt and a **completed application** by mail to:*
