△ Have you been discriminated against in applying for a rental unit or in the terms and conditions of renting a unit based on your **race, color, religion, sex, national origin, familial status (families with children), disability, age, marital status, sexual orientation, or source of your income?**

△ Have you been discriminated against in the sale of a house or applying for home loan financing?

△ Are you a tenant, potential homebuyer, property manager, or home lender who wants information on fair housing laws?

△ Are you a non-profit, social service, or local government agency that needs information, materials, or training on fair housing laws?
