








Water Conservation Data for November – December 2009



During November, the City of Woodland used 313,971,056 gallons of water, or 5,567 gallons per person. This amount was the third lowest water use for the month of November in the last 10 years. During December, the City used 246,765,232 gallons of water, or 4,375 gallons per person. This amount was the lowest water use for the month of December in the last 10 years.

The estimated monthly savings for November from city rebates and city leak repairs totaled 1,890 gallons. Savings for December totaled 1,980 gallons. In addition, city staff responded to 11 water waste reports and fixed 43 leaks in November and December. Public Works investigated 303 leaks in 2009.

Environmental Services reminds residents, businesses, and City departments to cut back on winter landscape watering and to reset your irrigation controllers for the cooler, wetter weather.
