




Water Conservation Data for January 2010



During January, the City of Woodland used 199,024,136 gallons of water, or 3,529 gallons per person. This amount was the lowest water use for the month of January in the last 11 years. The estimated monthly savings for January from city rebates and city leak repairs totaled 1,530 gallons. In addition, city staff responded to 10 water waste reports and fixed 17 leaks.

Environmental Services reminds residents, businesses, and City Departments to cut back on winter landscape watering and to reset your irrigation controllers for the cooler, wetter weather.
