




The 2008 GHG Donut


Energy Source Breakdown




2008 Electricity-Related Emissions

UPDATE:

Past GHG reporting was to the California Registry. Beginning in 2011, reporting to The Climate Registry.

MISSION:

To standardize and centralize high quality GHG data into a North American GHG registry to support voluntary and mandatory reporting programs

BOARD:

- 12 Canadian Provinces/Territories
- 41 U.S. States and D.C.
- **6 Mexican States**
- 4 Native Sovereign Nations

MEMBERS:

345+ Members/Reporters (includes 100 from the California Registry)



Key Points

- City wells and the WPCF are far and away the biggest energy users.
- Electricity usage accounts for 71% of Woodland's carbon footprint.
- Electricity usage was by 13.5% in 2008.
- PG&E supplied electricity in 2008 that was not as clean as in 2007, so Woodland's overall footprint was property by 13.9% in 2008.
- Gasoline and diesel fuel usage was in 2008.
- Transition to The Climate Registry reporting in 2011.
