# Mixed Recycling—

It's easy and can save you money

It is just as easy to toss a piece of paper into a recycling container as it is to toss it into a waste can. The City of Woodland, through its franchised waste service provider, Waste Management, provides recycling services for commercial customers. The program, called a MIXED RECYCLING program, allows a business to recycle paper, cardboard and beverage containers all in a single receptacle. Customers using commercial waste removal services in the City of Woodland are eligible for recycling services at a minimal monthly charge.

## How to Get Started

- Call the Waste Management Customer Service Center at **530-662-8748** to request an assessment of your recycling needs.
- A waste audit assessment will help you decide which programs to implement. Waste Management will provide you with educational support materials for your employees
- A large bin or wheeled cart for mixed recycling materials will be provided
- Simply place all your mixed recycling into one container for collection by Waste Management

## WHAT TO INCLUDE HOW TO PREPARE

### CANS & PLASTIC



- Aluminum cans
- Tin cans
- Plastic milk & water jugs
- Mixed plastic bottles & Containers
- Remove caps
- Rinse



*REMEMBER Flattening your materials saves space and energy!*

### NO PLASTIC BAGS OR STYROFOAM



### GLASS

- Glass bottles & jars
- Remove bottle caps & jar lids and place in container
- Pickle jars • Juice bottles • Jelly jars
- Any color glass, bottle or jar



*No need to remove labels*

### PAPER & CARDBOARD



- Loose newspaper
- Paper board
- Cardboard
- Magazines
- Office paper & junk mail



- Corrugated boxes
- Brown grocery bags
- Glossy paper
- Cereal boxes (no liners)
- 6-Pack cartons
- Cracker boxes

- Stationery & envelopes
- Binder paper
- Notebook paper - any color
- Adhesive backed or sticky paper
