


Water Conservation Data for March 2010







During March, the City of Woodland used 269,809,910 gallons of water, or 4,784 gallons per person. This amount was the lowest water use for the month of March in the last 5 years. The estimated monthly savings for March from city rebates and city leak repairs totaled 5,472 gallons. In addition, city staff responded to 9 water waste reports and fixed 16 leaks.

Environmental Services Staff distributed 23 hose nozzles, 38 soil moisture meters, 61 toilet leak detection dye tablets, 52 adult water-wise kits (including information on household and landscape water conservation), and 12 kids water-wise kits (including activities on water conservation, drought, and storm water).
