LIBRARY ROSE CLUB PROPOSAL:

Representatives of the Woodland Library Rose Club presented a proposal for expansion of the Library Rose Garden adjacent to the Library. This includes the proposed conversion of the current parking lot at Court and College Streets and the graveled parking lot between North Street and Carnegie Way to rose gardens.

Bette Francis, Chair of the Library Board of Trustees, was asked by Council what the Board's feelings were about the proposal. She indicated the Board felt it was a beautiful design that needed review by the Council and community. It was not inconsistent with the future plans of the Library.

Council Members expressed their individual opinions and questions about the proposal. There was general agreement to let the Club circulate the proposal for community consideration prior to a final Council decision. It was expected this could occur in March or April 1995, as the Council also considers recommendations from the Downtown Parking Committee.
