The Woodland City Council met in adjourned session at 7:03 p.m. in the City Hall Council Chambers.

ROLL CALL:

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Lois Linford, representing the League of Women Voters of Woodland, thanked the Council for conducting this meeting since the League views water issues as very important for the community. Also, Elizabeth Tara of Woodland urged the City to take more action to stop the waste of water in the community.

OVERVIEW/BACKGROUND OF WATER ISSUES:

Staff from the City Public Works Department gave an overview and background on water issues; basic water law; the City's water system; activities of the Water Resources Association of Yolo County; and discussed various supplemental surface water supplies.

SURFACE WATER:

Jim Eagan, General Manager of the Yolo County Flood Control and Water Conservation District, reviewed the District's activities and its application for surface water from the Sacramento River on behalf of local communities including Woodland.

SUPPLEMENTAL WATER ISSUES:

Council expressed interest in seeing a proposal on a possible joint study with Conaway on land use and supplemental water issues of mutual interest. Council also expressed interest in exploring as many options as possible to enhance the quality and quantity of City water. Staff will return to the Council with a plan for the necessary additional engineering and legal assistance to investigate the various options before the City.

Twyla Thompson, Chair of the Woodland Chamber of Commerce Water Committee, congratulated the Council on its stated directions on water policy. She stated the Chamber's interest in assisting the City in these issues.

Mike Volonte suggested the City take further steps to control water waste.
