Public Works staff also discussed proposed new tree maintenance policies responding to the cutbacks in tree maintenance staffing which went into effect July 1994. Similarly, proposed new sidewalk maintenance polices were discussed responding to other cutbacks imposed July 1994. Further information was requested. These issues will return to Council for action at the Council's October 18 meeting.
