Rominger and Steve E. Borchard, having received the highest number of votes for two vacancies on the Council, were elected Council Members. Ann Hanson was reelected as City Treasurer, and Jean Winnop was reelected as City Clerk.

On motion of Council Member Slaven, seconded by Council Member Borchard and carried by unanimous vote, the City Council appointed Elaine Rominger as Vice Mayor.

#### REMARKS FROM COUNCIL MEMBERS:

Newly sworn Council Members Borchard and Rominger gave thanks to family and friends who helped with their respective campaigns and talked about their hopes for serving on the Council for the next four years. Council Members Flory and Slaven and Mayor Sandy also commented on their desires for their upcoming years on the Council.
