HONORING BUILT-RITE TRAILERS FOR ROLL-OVER SIMULATOR:

A demonstration of the City's roll-over simulator was conducted. The simulator will be made available to the other agencies within Yolo County. The simulator was developed with use of grant funding.

POLICE DEPARTMENT ANNUAL REPORT:

Chief McDonell presented the annual report of the Yolo County Communications Emergency Services Agency. He said 1992 is the fifth year of the joint powers authority for communications and is a cost effective way of coordinating communication services of the cities and County of Yolo County.

Council Member Flory suggested that Council hold a study session at the Communications Center.

Chief McDonell presented the Annual Police Department Report. The trend over the last four years is that the number crimes has been reduced. However, there was an increase in 1991. The Police Department's response time is 6.22 minutes on the average.

JOINT SESSION WITH COMMISSION ON AGING:

John Ferns, Chairperson of the Commission on Aging, reviewed the functions of the Commission as provided by City Ordinance No. 1035. He said the role of the Commission is to define the needs of senior citizens. The question posed to Council by Commission Members is "Can the Commission on Aging and Child Care Commission provide input on their respective division operating budgets?"

Commission Members expressed concerns over space and parking at the Senior Center.

Council Member Flory suggested that City Council establish policy on relationships and roles of the Commissions. Vice Mayor Sandy asked the Commission to submit any changes to the Ordinance that they would like to be considered by the Council.
