WOODLAND CITY COUNCIL ADJOURNED MEETING

The Woodland City Council met in adjourned session at 7:00 p.m. in the Yolo County Public Agency Risk Management Insurance Authority Conference Room.

ROLL CALL:

COUNCIL MEMBERS PRESENT: Rominger, Crescione, Flory, Sandy, Slaven

COUNCIL MEMBERS ABSENT: None

CITY STAFF PRESENT: Kristensen, O'Toole

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Bud Fisk said he was representing the owner of property at Sixth Street and Lincoln Avenue, a proposed site for the Woodland Police Station relocation and was attending the goal setting session for information only.

CITY GOALS FOR FUTURE:

Mayor Elaine Rominger gave Council a review of the goal setting session which occurred on July 14, 1990.

City Manager Kris Kristensen stated that the purpose of this session is to establish two-year goals for the City with implementing tasks. The process included a review of the 1990 goals established. New goals were developed by reviewing the positive attributes of the City and reviewing issues where improvement is needed. From this exercise the Council formed new goals.

Tasks for implementation of the goals will be developed at a later meeting.

Mayor Rominger suggested Council Members assign themselves to specific goals as a Committee to develop specific tasks to implement each goal:

Establish general fund self-sufficiency and stability - Council Members

Crescione and Slaven

Economic and Redevelopment - Council Member Flory and Mayor Rominger

Communication - Council Members Flory and Sandy

Next goal/task meeting will be July 30, 1992, after the General Plan orientation meeting. Committee members will bring back a task list of their specific goals. Staff will provide tasks for other goals.

COUNCIL POLICIES AND PROCEDURES:

Mayor Rominger advised Council Members that she would like to share some of the ceremonial functions with other Council Members. Vice Mayor Sandy suggested that the agenda creation process be rotated.

The City Manager asked if the Council meeting schedule was satisfactory. Vice Mayor Sandy suggested using the second Tuesdays of the month for special meetings. Alternatives will be discussed at a later date.

Council Member Flory suggested that the City develop a policy on proclamations. Council Member Slaven suggested and Council Members agreed that the Council Members' names be typed on proclamations, and the Mayor will sign them. Council agreed that proclamations such as service retirements will be signed by all Council Members.

Council Members agreed to try and pick up their agenda binders, and if they do not by a time certain, the City Manager's Secretary Jane Gravink will deliver them.
