CACHE CREEK SETTLING BASIN:

State Reclamation Board staff representative Cliff Gregory reviewed the State's plans to improve the Cache Creek Settling Basin. Levees in the basin will be raised 12 feet to reduce Cache Creek sediment from entering the Yolo Bypass. The \$24 million project will be paid by the State (approximately \$8 million) and the Federal government. Construction is scheduled to begin this Fall.

The project causes the City some concerns regarding its effect on the City's discharge of storm drainage. Staff will work with the State to find a solution to these concerns.
