

A DIRECTORY FOR CONSTRUCTION & DEMOLITION MATERIALS



WELCOME TO THE BUILDER'S DIRECTORY to Reuse and Recycling. The purpose of this Guide is to help builders, contractors, and residents reuse and recycle construction and demolition (C&D) materials. This Guide includes an easy index of who's who in local recycling to help you find a home for C&D wastes.

In 1989 the State of California mandated that all cities reduce landfilled waste by 50% in the year 2000 and beyond. Even though recycling throughout California has increased, landfilled waste continues to grow, mainly due to increased construction activities.

To encourage C&D recycling, the City of Woodland adopted a C&D Recycling Debris Ordinance. This ordinance requires contractors and builders to recycle 50% of their debris. It is the contractors and builders responsibility to collect and keep all weight tickets regarding recycling and solid waste in order to comply with the ordinance. Waste Management is the exclusive franchise hauler for trash, therefore if you select another hauler they may only pick up recyclables. The ordinance is online at www.cityofwoodland.org.

Use this guide to assist you with City ordinance compliance and reducing the disposal of valuable resources. Please call the companies before your construction or demolition project begins to confirm hours of operation and acceptance of materials you wish to recycle.

How can you help?



REDUCE

- Choose materials that are durable so you don't have to replace them frequently.

- Instead of traditional demolition, consider salvage and deconstruction by selectively and carefully removing materials for reuse.
- Consider remodeling or retrofitting existing building for new use.
- Allow time in your schedule for salvage and recycling.

RECYCLE

- Recycling can save you money. Ask your contractor to recycle.
- Clean loads are the key to successful recycling. Be sure that your idea of a clean load is the same as your recyclers'.
- Early on, set up the site locations for reuse and recycling.

Special Waste

Hazardous Waste & E-Waste

Hazardous Waste (HW) and Electronic Waste (E-Waste) are banned from the landfill. Many types of HW and E-Waste are found at construction and demolition sites. These materials must be identified and handled correctly prior to demolition or during construction.

How to Use This Directory

Directory Information



This directory is a listing of area recyclers compiled from information provided to the City of Woodland. It does not constitute a recommendation and may not be all-inclusive.

For fast reference to service providers by material, check the **Quick Guide**. Refer to the **Recyclers Directory** section for detailed information, in alphabetical order, on hours of operation, services provided, website, and physical address.

Use the **Conversion Factor** chart to assist you in filling out the C&D Debris Recycling Quarterly and End of Project Report.

Please call listings for costs and additional service expectations.

Definitions of terms:

- **C&D:** The acronym C&D will be used throughout this directory. It stands for Construction & Demolition.
- **Source-separated C&D recycling** is the process of collecting sorted recyclable materials in separate on-site containers which are taken to different facilities for recycling.
- **Co-mingled C&D recycling** is the process of collecting mixed recyclable materials in one container on-site which is taken to a sorting facility where materials are separated for recycling. Co-mingled containers must contain at least 90% recyclable materials.

Setting Up a Job-Site Recycling Program

Rising landfill fees have made disposal of construction and demolition debris a significant expense. Reducing the amount of material going to the landfill lowers the cost of doing business.

Are There Dollars in Your Dumpster?

Identify Recyclables

Don't forget to set up recycling for beverage containers and paper.

Asphalt, concrete, cardboard, drywall, metals and wood are easy to recycle in Woodland. Recycling options also exist for asphalt roofing, carpet, carpet padding, ceiling tiles and film plastic.

Choose a Recycling Method There are three basic approaches to job-site recycling:

- ☑ **Contract with a recycling hauler who accepts co-mingled C&D materials.** This service allows contractors to put multiple recyclables such as wood, cardboard and metals in one container.
- ☑ **Separate recyclables at the source for recycling.** This method involves collecting recyclables in separate containers as they are generated.
- ☑ **Self-haul your recyclables.** Source-separate recyclables on-site and haul them yourself to local recyclers. You may be able to drop off co-mingled loads at recyclers. Call ahead to confirm.

Select a Recycler Specify in an agreement with the recycling service provider:

- ☑ What materials will be recycled?
- ☑ Requirement that weight or volume of recyclables be documented.
- ☑ Costs associated with the service.
- ☑ Schedule for picking up containers.
- ☑ How containers will be labeled.

Involve Sub-contractors

Include language in sub-contractor agreements that they will recycle. Discuss the recycling program at every safety meeting or other regular meetings.

Monitor the Program

- ☑ Designate a Site Waste-Management Person.
- ☑ Check dumpsters regularly to make sure material is getting separated properly.

Special Waste

Roofing or Drywall

As landfill availability decreases and tipping fees increase, solid waste generators are becoming more interested in finding alternative ways of managing shingle waste.




Asphalt shingle scrap can be used in a variety of products, including:

- Asphalt pavement
- Aggregate base and subbase, Cold patch for potholes, sidewalks, utility cuts, driveways, ramps, bridges and parking lots
- Pothole patch
- Road and ground cover
- New roofing
- Fuel Oil

Drywall Recycling

- New Drywall – recycled into new drywall (Company outside California)
- Soil Amendment – new construction drywall
- Boron – plant nutrient in small amounts



Reuse of Drywall

- Gunite Support – used as forms
- Construction Sites – scraps can be put in the interior wall cavities
- Donation – Habitat for Humanity will take half size or larger

Carpet & Carpet Pad Recycling

Disposed carpet continues to be a challenging construction and demolition (C&D) waste in California. Carpet and carpet padding is expected to grow by a least 44 percent over the next ten years!!

The upper portion of carpet is made from yarn or fiber. There are several types of fiber used, including nylon 6, nylon 6,6, wool, cotton, olefin, acrylic, rayon, and polyester. However, out of all these fibers, only nylon

Currently, less than 5 percent of carpet and carpet padding is being recycled and less than 1 percent is reused.

Disposal Options

REUSE

Habitat for Humanity is an organization that may find use for good reusable carpet, although it may require a minimum carpet quantity of about 800 sq ft. Refer to the *Directory of Facilities* for a Habitat for Humanity near you.

RECYCLING

Old carpets may also be used to produce other products, such as auto parts, plastic lumber, parking stops, and carpet pads. Below are two locations within the Sacramento Area that can recycle carpet and carpet pads. Please call ahead to confirm acceptable materials and for more information.

Useful Information

Construction, Remodeling & Demolition

All activities related to the construction, remodeling, and demolition of buildings and structures may require a permit from the **Building Division**.....**530-661-5820**



C&D Debris Recycling Ordinance

Depending on location, type and size of project, all contractors and developers, when applying for a building permit, must comply with the City of Woodland C&D Debris Recycling Ordinance. If applicable you **must** follow these procedures to stay in compliance and avoid unnecessary fines and delays:

- Before receiving your building or demolition permit you must complete and submit the following:
 - **Waste Reduction Recycling Plan**
 - **Administrative Fee** (\$275 for each building/demolition permit)
 - **Deposit**
- During construction or demolition you must:
 - **Collect receipts/weight tickets** for each material from vendors or facilities used. The receipts/weight tickets must be clearly labeled with the project title and date.
 - **Submit Quarterly Waste Reduction and Recycling reports** on the 30th of April, June, Oct. & Jan.
- Before final inspection, you must complete and submit a **Waste Reduction and Recycling Report**.

C&D Debris Recycling Ordinance Packet

When applying for a building or demolition permit, to help stay in compliance, contractors and developers will receive a C&D Debris Recycling Ordinance Packet. The Packet includes:
