



**NOTICE OF FUNDING AVAILABILITY (NOFA)**  
**FOR THE CITY OF WOODLAND**  
**COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM**

Notice is given herewith that the City of Woodland's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program has \$513,442 in funds available for Fiscal Year 2020/21.

The purpose of the Federal CDBG Program is to undertake eligible activities that will carry out the primary objectives of Title 1 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended. These objectives are designed to provide decent housing, a suitable living environment, and to expand economic opportunities primarily for persons of low and moderate income. Low and moderate income is defined as persons making 80% or less of the area median income in Woodland. As per HUD directives, priority is given to applicants providing services to Americans serving our Country and applicants who have demonstrated the ability to complete projects in a timely basis.

All interested parties are invited to attend an application workshop/public meeting on **Friday, March 6, 2020 at 1:30 p.m.** in the Conference Room of the Woodland Community and Senior Center at 2001 East Street, Woodland, CA 95776 to discuss the 2020/21 CDBG application and scoring criteria and to receive citizen input on the 2020/21 CDBG Program.
