WHAT HELP IS AVAILABLE?

- Renters can apply for help paying rent, utilities, and other charges owed to their landlords.
- There are also legal protections against evictions if you owe rent from April 2020 to March 2022. Tenants must take steps to get the protections. Call us for more information.

If you get court eviction papers you must respond. Seek legal advice right away.

TO BEST PROTECT YOURSELF FROM EVICTION:

1. Apply for help paying rent and other charges at HousingisKey.com;
2. Write your landlord to tell them that you applied and for what months you applied; and
3. Pay your rent for April on time. You should include a letter that tells the landlord this rent is for April 2022.
